CHAPTER 338

AN ACT to amend 196.67 (2) of the statutes, relating to warning signs on electric transmission line poles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

196.67 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

196.67(2) Every such sign shall be in red or, black, orange or reflective letters not less than 2 inches high on a contrasting background of white and shall read "Danger—High Voltage." The commission may establish standards for electric transmission line pole signs having at least equivalent warning qualities to signs specified in this subsection, and warning signs meeting standards established or approved by the commission shall be deemed to be in compliance with this section.
