CHAPTER 367

AN ACT to create 23.09 (7) (0) of the statutes, relating to acceptance of gifts and grants by the conservation commission.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

23.09 (7) (o) of the statutes is created to read:

23.09 (7) (o) Gifts and grants. The commission is authorized to accept and administer any gifts, grants, bequests and devises, including funds made available to it by the federal government under any act of congress relating to any of the functions of the commission; but all funds included in such gifts, grants, bequests and devises received or expected to be received by the commission in a biennium shall be included in the statement of its actual and estimated receipts and disbursements for such bi-

ennium required to be contained in the biennial state budget report under s. 16.46, and shall be deemed to be and treated the same as other actual and estimated receipts and disbursements of the commission.
