CHAPTER 400

AN ACT to amend 29.174 (2) of the statutes, relating to the authority of the conservation commission to limit the number of turkey hunters in any area.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly. do enact as follows:

29.174 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.174 (2) (a) It is the duty of The conservation commission and it shall have power and authority to establish open and close closed seasons, bag limits, size limits, rest days and other conditions governing the taking of fish or game, in accordance with the public policy declared in sub. (1), but all fishing seasons on inland waters shall open on a Saturday. Such authority may be exercised either with reference to the state as a whole, or for any specified county or part of a county, or for any lake or stream or part thereof. The requirements of ch. 227 regarding public hearings are waived on rules relating to opening of fishing seasons for 1961.

(b) The commission may regulate and limit the number of hunters and the maximum harvest of wild turkeys in any area.
