CHAPTER 413

AN ACT to create 285.11 (1) of the statutes, relating to attorney's fees for state employes falsely accused of abuse of institution inmates.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

285.11 (1) of the statutes is created to read:

285.11 (1) Any state employe against whom charges are filed under s. 940.29, and who is subsequently found not guilty, shall be reimbursed by the state for reasonable attorney's fees and costs in defending such action.

(2) Claims against the state under this section shall be filed with the commission as provided in s. 285.06.

(3) On receipt of such a claim the commission shall determine whether the claim is authorized by this section and if so shall determine the amount of attorney's fees and costs incurred and shall allow such attorney's fees and costs as in its judgment are reasonable.
