CHAPTER 42

AN ACT to renumber 70.47 (3) ; and to create 70.47 (3) (b) of the statutes, relating to the time of first board of review meetings.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 70.47 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 70.47 (3) (a).

SECTION 2. 70.47 (3) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

70.47 (3) (b) The municipal governing body may by ordinance or resolution designate hours, other than those set forth in par. (a), during which the board shall hold its first meeting, but not fewer than 4 hours on the first meeting day between 8 a.m. and 12 p.m. Such change in the time shall not become effective unless notice thereof is published in the official newspaper if in a city, or posted in not less than 3 public places if in any other municipality, at least 10 days before such first meeting.
