## **CHAPTER 45**

AN ACT to amend 12.16 of the statutes, relating to publishing the candidate's address in all campaign literature issued in his behalf.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

12.16 of the statutes is amended to read:

12.16 No person shall publish, issue or circulate or cause to be published, issued or circulated otherwise than in a newspaper, as provided in s. 12.14 (1), any literature or any publication tending to influence voting at any election or primary, which fails to bear on the face thereof the given name, given and surname, and address of the author, the given name, given and surname, and address of the candidate in whose behalf the same is published, issued or circulated, and the given name, given and surname, and address of any other person causing the same to be published, issued or circulated.
