CHAPTER 466

AN ACT to amend 10.02 (1) of the statutes, relating to an election commission executive secretary in cities of the 1st class.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 10.02 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

10.02 (1) Said The board of election commissioners shall shall have power to employ a an executive secretary, who shall prepare and furnish copies of all registrations and all books, maps, instructions and blanks for the use and guidance of inspectors of election and ballot clerks and all rules and regulations pertaining to registration and conduct of elections, and who shall perform such other and further duties pertaining to their department or to the city clerk's office as may be required of him by the board of election commissioners, and he shall receive such salary as the common council may determine determines. The appointment and removal of such executive secretary shall be subject to the civil service laws of this state applicable to such cities. Whenever reference is made to the secretary of the board of election commissioners of cities of the 1st class, such reference is to the executive secretary.

SECTION 2. The change in the title of the office of secretary of the board of election commissioners to executive secretary shall not impair any rights or privileges of the person now serving as secretary who will hereafter be known as executive secretary
