CHAPTER 470

AN ACT to amend 66.918 (1) (a) of the statutes, relating to the deduction of premiums for supplementary medical coverage under federal social security in the case of annuitants under the Wisconsin retirement fund.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.918 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.918 (1) (a) None of the moneys mentioned in ss. 66.90 to 66.918 shall be assignable, either in law or equity, or be subject to execution, levy, attachment, garnishment or other legal process. An annuitant may *in writing*, however, direct the fund to deduct premiums for group insurance carried under s. 66.919 and to pay such moneys into the general fund to the credit of s. 20.408 (41), and may also in writing direct the fund to deduct premiums for supplementary medical coverage under federal social security and pay such moneys to the social security administration.
