CHAPTER 489

AN ACT to create 66.99 (3t) of the statutes, relating to the inclusion of teachers under federal social security.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.99 (3t) of the statutes is created to read:

66.99 (3t) Effective July 1, 1966, all services performed by teachers in positions covered by the retirement systems pursuant to ss. 38.24 and 42.20 to 42.531, but who are ineligible to be members of such retirement system, shall be covered under the federal old age, survivors and disability insurance system. This shall not affect the status of members of the separate group of either retirement system who became members of the separate group by reason of eligibility for a choice in 1957 pursuant to ss. 38.24 (3) (d) and 42.241 (4).
