CHAPTER 504

AN ACT to create 966.065 of the statutes, permitting a witness examined at an inquest to have counsel present at the examination.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

966.065 of the statutes is created to read:

966.065 COUNSEL. Any witness examined at an inquest may have counsel present at the examination but such counsel shall not be allowed to examine his client, cross-examine other witnesses or argue before the person holding the inquest.
