CHAPTER 512

AN ACT to repeal 108.02 (5) (f) 12 of the statutes, relating to including employment by the state legislature as covered employment under the unemployment compensation law.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 108.02 (5) (f) 12 of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. Under this act benefit credits shall accrue, under section 108.06 (1) of the statutes, for all work done in the employ of the state legislature after January 1, 1965; but benefits shall be payable hereunder only for weeks of unemployment beginning after the effective date of this act.
