Chapter 540

AN ACT to amend 66.99 (3t) of the statutes, as created by chapter 489, laws of 1965, relating to the inclusion of teachers under the federal social security insurance system.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.99 (3t) of the statutes, as created by chapter 489, laws of 1965, is amended to read:

66.99 (3t) Effective July 1, 1966, all services performed by teachers in positions covered by the retirement systems pursuant to ss. 38.24 and 42.20 to 42.531, but who are ineligible to be members of such retirement system, shall be covered under the federal old age, survivors and disability insurance system *if such coverage is not prohibited by federal law or regulation*. This shall not affect the status of members of the separate group of either retirement system who became members of the separate group by reason of eligibility for a choice in 1957 pursuant to ss. 38.24 (3) (d) and 42.241 (4).
