## Chapter 558

AN ACT to amend 35.76 of the statutes, relating to bids for printing the supreme court reports.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

35.76 of the statutes is amended to read:

35.76 Commencing in the first week in October next preceding each contract period, the director shall advertise for 6 successive weeks in newspapers, each of which is published in a different eity of the state as a class 3 notice, under ch. 985, in the official state newspaper, that sealed proposals for printing, publishing and delivering the supreme court reports as required by this chapter will be received by said director and

there publicly opened and read at a specified time, and that upon application said director will furnish to bidders all necessary information and blanks. The director may include in the specification proposals a provision that the contract price shall be adjusted from time to time during the term of the contract as affected by an increase or decrease in the printers' wage scale and paper and binding costs.
