## Chapter 579

AN ACT to repeal 20.930 (1) (a) (line 7); and to amend 220.02 (2) of the statutes, relating to the salary of the deputy commissioner of banks and validating prior payments therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.930 (1) (a) (line 7) of the statutes is repealed.

Section 2. 220.02 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

220.02 (2) The commissioner shall appoint a deputy under the classified service. He shall possess all powers and perform the duties attached to the office of commissioner during a vacancy thereof and during the absence or inability of the commissioner. The commissioner may also employ such examiners and clerks to assist him and his deputy in the discharge of the several duties imposed upon him by this chapter as he shall find finds necessary, and who shall perform such other duties as the commissioner directs. Salaries of the examiners and other employes shall be fixed by the commissioner with the approval of the banking review board,

SECTION 3. All payments of moneys to deputy commissioners of banks prior to January 1, 1966, as salary under a classification established in the state civil service and which were in excess of the salary prescribed for that office in section 20.930 (1) (a) (line 7) of the statutes are hereby validated.
