Chapter 598

AN ACT to renumber 204.30 (5), as created by chapter 486, laws of 1965; and to create 204.30 (5) (b) of the statutes, relating to uninsured motorist coverage in automobile liability insurance policies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 204.30 (5) of the statutes, as created by chapter 486, laws of 1965, is renumbered 204.30 (5) (a).

SECTION 2. 204.30 (5) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

204.30 (5) (b) For purposes of this coverage, "uninsured motor vehicle" includes an insured motor vehicle if before or after the accident the liability insurer of the motor vehicle is declared insolvent by a court of competent jurisdiction. In such case, the insurer making payment under the uninsured motorists' coverage shall, to the extent of the payment, be subrogated to the rights of its insured. This extension of coverage shall apply only with respect to accidents occuring after July 1, 1966.
