Chapter 610

AN ACT to repeal 45.35 (5c); and to amend 45.396, as amended by chapters 293 and 433, laws of 1965, of the statutes, relating to grants to veterans.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 45.35 (5c) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. 45.396 of the statutes, as amended by chapters 293 and 433, laws of 1965, is amended to read:

45.396 Any honorably discharged veteran as defined in s. 45.35 (5a) (a) to (g), upon the completion of any correspondence courses or parttime classroom study from the university of Wisconsin, the university of Wisconsin extension division, or any state college or its extension division or any post high school courses from any school of vocational, *technical* and adult education as established under s. 41.15 receiving aids from the state board of vocational, *technical* and adult education, taken upon authorization of the Wisconsin department of veterans affairs, may be reimbursed for the cost of such courses, including necessary textbooks, by the department upon presentation to the department of a certificate from the school indicating that he has completed the courses and stating the cost of such courses and necessary textbooks. Benefits granted under this section shall be paid out of the appropriation $\frac{1}{10}$ under s. 20.840 (2) (um).
