- AN ACT to amend 51.36 (8) (a) of the statutes, relating to community mental health clinic services.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
 - 51.36 (8) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 51.36 (8) (a) The director is authorized to may make state grants-in-aid which shall be based upon 40 per cent state and 60 per cent local sharing of the total expenditures for: 1. salaries; 2. contract facilities and

services; 3. operation, maintenance and service costs; 4. per diem and travel expense of members of community mental health boards; and 5. purchase of community mental health clinic services from clinics established elsewhere, including out-of-state clinics; and 6. other expenditures specifically approved and authorized by the director. The grants may not be used to match other state or federal funds which may be available to clinics. No grants shall be made for capital expenditures.
