## Chapter 634

AN ACT to repeal 77.53 (18), 139.02 (2) and 139.03 (4); and to amend 77.52 (3) of the statutes, relating to deleting obsolete statements as to presumptions arising from the imposition of various taxes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 77.52 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

77.52 (3) The taxes imposed by this section may be collected from the consumer or user. All taxes imposed by this section shall conclusively be presumed to be direct taxes on the retail consumer, advanced and propaid for the purpose of convenience and facility only.

SECTION 2. 77.53 (18) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. 139.02 (2) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 4. 139.03 (4) of the statutes is repealed.
