- AN ACT to amend 56.065 (3) and (4) (a), as created by chapter 300, laws of 1965; and to create 56.08 (13) of the statutes, relating to housing for prison inmates participating in a work release plan.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
 - SECTION 1. 56.08 (13) of the statutes is created to read:
- 56.08 (13) Any county board may contract with the department of public welfare for the quartering in the county jail of inmates under s. 56.065.
- SECTION 2. 56.065 (3) and (4) (a) of the statutes, as created by chapter 300, laws of 1965, are amended to read:
- 56.065 (3) The department shall designate and adapt facilities of the state prisons for the purpose of quartering inmates with work release privileges or it may arrange and contract for other facilities, including portions of county jails for inmates employed in the area. No inmate shall be granted work release privileges until such suitable quarters in a prison facility have been provided in the area of accepted or proffered employment.
- (4) (a) Every inmate gainfully employed under a work release program shall be liable for the cost of his board and clothing at the prison and for any expenses incident to such employment.
