CHAPTER 64

AN ACT to amend 192.268 of the statutes, relating to railroad track motor cars.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

192.268 of the statutes is amended to read:

192.268 It is unlawful after January 1, 1965, for any person operating or controlling any railroad running through or within the state to operate or use in motion any track motor car, without a canopy or top, a windshield and windshield wiper, and a curtain on both sides and a roll curtain on each side and the rear enclosed by panels or curtains, removable or fixed, to adequately protect the occupants thereof from the weather. This section shall apply only to track motor cars which operate regularly outside the confines of the railroad yards.
