- AN ACT to create 20.830 (1) (d) of the statutes, relating to an appropriation to the university to assist the development of an industry employing the handicapped.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. At the appropriate place in the schedule in section 20.005 (2) (a) of the statutes, insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

SECTION 2. 20.830 (1) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

20.830 (1) (d) Handicapped industries assistance. As a continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule to be used by the department of agricultural and extension education of the university for the purpose of assisting the development of business operations involving the handicapped. Receipts from the sale of products, to the extent of the amount appropriated hereunder for materials expense in connection with such products, shall be credited to this appropriation for use in financing this activity. Any balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse, but shall remain available for the purposes herein specified.
