CHAPTER 93

AN ACT to amend 62.23 (6) (a) of the statutes, relating to adoption of official maps.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

62.23 (6) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

62.23 (6) (a) The council of every city may by ordinance or resolution establish an official map of the city or any part thereof showing the streets, highways, parkways, parks and playgrounds theretofore laid out, adopted and established by law, and such map is to be deemed to be final and conclusive with respect to the location and width of streets, highways and parkways, and the location and extent of parks and playgrounds shown thereon. Such official map is declared to be established to conserve and promote the public health, safety, convenience or general welfare. Said ordinance or resolution shall make it the duty of the city clerk at once to file with the register of deeds of the county or counties in which such city is situated a certificate showing that the city has established such official map. An ordinance or resolution establishing any part of an official map enacted prior to the effective date of this amendment (1965) which would be valid under this paragraph is hereby validated.
