CHAPTER 12, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 103.73 (1) (intro.) and (2) of the statutes, relating to employment permits of minors

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 103.73 (1) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

103.73 (1) (intro.) The permit provided for in under s. 103.70 shall state the name, and the date and place of birth of the minor, the color of hair and eyes, the height and weight and env distinguishing facial marks of such minor, and that the following evidence, records and papers have been duly examined, approved and filed:

SECTION 2. 103.73 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

103.73 (2) The permits provided for in under s. 103.70 shall be issued upon blanks furnished by the commission and shall be made out in duplicate. One copy shall be forthwith sent to the commission together with a detailed statement of in quadruplicate, showing the character and substance of the evidence offered prior to the issuance of such permit. Such statement shall be made by the permit officer upon blanks furnished by the commission. The other copy One copy shall be sent to the commission, 2 copies of the permit shall be sent by the permit officer to the prospective employer of the minor for whom the permit was issued and one copy shall be retained by the issuing officer.
