CHAPTER 139, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 966.20 (1) (intro.) of the statutes, relating to notification of coroners and medical examiners of deaths in other counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

966.20 (1) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

966.20 (1) (intro.) All physicians, authorities of hospitals, sanatoriums, institutions (public and private), convalescent homes, authorities of any institution of a like nature, and other persons having knowledge of the death of any person who has died under any of the following circumstances, shall immediately report such death to the sheriff, police chief, or coroner of the county wherein such death took place, and the sheriff or police chief shall, immediately upon notification, notify the coroner or, in counties having a population of 500,000 or more, the medical examiner and the coroner or medical examiner of the county where death took place, if the crime, injury or event occurred in another county, shall report such death immediately to the coroner or medical examiner of that county:
