CHAPTER 158, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to remember 13.45 (3); and to create 13.45 (3) (b) and (c) of the statutes, relating to reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred by members of committees under chapter 13 who are not legislators.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 13.45 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 13.45 (3) (a).

SECTION 2. 13.45 (3) (b) and (c) of the statutes are created to read: 13.45 (3) (b) Unless otherwise provided by law, any state officer or employe representing his agency as a member of a committee under this chapter shall be reimbursed by his agency for his actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his duties as a committee member.

(c) Unless otherwise provided by law, any member of a committee under this chapter and not covered by par. (a) or (b) shall be reimbursed from the appropriation of the committee of which he is a member for his actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his duties as a committee member.
