## CHAPTER 168, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 95.24 (1) of the statutes, relating to possession or furnishing of hog cholera vaccines.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

95.24 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

95.24 (1) No person shall have in his possession or furnish to another any live virus hog cholera vaccine or other substance capable of producing hog cholera, including vaccines produced from a modified or attenuated strain of hog cholera virus, except that any such substance vaccines may be in the possession of a biological laboratory inspected and licensed by the federal government or a person who has, persons having written approval from the department for its experimental use, or veterinarians having a permit from the department for its use in vaccinating or treating swine as necessary for export or for such other uses as are authorized by the department for the control of serious outbreaks of the disease.
