CHAPTER 175, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 63.05 (2) of the statutes, relating to preference to veterans on county or city civil service examinations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

63.05 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

63.05 (2) The commission shall impose no restrictions as to age in case of veterans and in the certification of eligibles, other conditions being equal, shall give preference to veterans of any of the wars of the U.S., including the Korean or Viet Nam conflict. "Viet Nam conflict" means service in accordance with the dates specified in s. 45.35 (5a) or as currently or subsequently defined by the congress of the United States or executive order. "Preference is hereby defined to mean "means that whenever an honorably discharged veteran competes in any examination before the commission and passes the minimum grade he shall be accorded 5 points, and if such veteran has a disability which is directly or indirectly traceable to war service, he shall be accorded another 5 points, in addition to earned ratings therein.
