AN ACT to create 204.30 (7) of the statutes, relating to insurance policies containing motorcycle coverage.

204.30 (7) MOTORCYCLE COVERAGE. Any bond or policy of insurance covering liability to others by reason of the operation of a motorcycle, which excludes coverage for the protection of passengers riding on such motorcycle shall contain the following words on the face of the bond or policy or words of equal effect which are acceptable to the commissioner of insurance: "THIS POLICY DOES NOT PROVIDE COVERAGE AGAINST LOSS OR LIABILITY TO PASSENGERS ON THE COVERED MOTORCYCLE". These words shall be printed, stamped or otherwise placed on the bond or policy in such size and location as to provide full notice to the insured that loss or liability to passengers is not covered.
