CHAPTER, 191, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to create 16.83 of the statutes, creating an advisory printing committee to the department of administration.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

16.83 of the statutes is created to read:

16.83 PRINTING COMMITTEE. An advisory printing committee is created composed of 6 members appointed by the commissioner for 2-year

terms. The committee shall confer with the commissioner on policies and procedures with respect to the printing activities of the state and advise him on such matters. The committee shall meet with the commissioner a least quarterly. The committee may request reports, through the department, pertinent to its functions from any state agency. Two of the members shall be from state agencies, 2 shall be representatives of the major trade association representing the commercial printing industry in the state, and 2 shall be persons knowledgeable in graphic communication, not representing either the state or the printing industry. The committee shall designate one of its number chairman. The commissioner shall appoint a secretary.
