CHAPTER 2, LAWS OF 1967

- AN ACT to renumber 253.195; and to create 253.195 (2) of the statutes, relating to temporary service by retired county judges.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
 - SECTION 1. 253.195 of the statutes is renumbered 253.195 (1).
 - SECTION 2. 253.195 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

253.195 (2) The administrator of courts may designate a retired county judge to serve temporarily as a county judge during the term for which such retired judge was elected for such time as the administrator determines and until his successor is elected or appointed and qualifies, whichever is sooner, and while so serving such designee may exercise all of the jurisdiction of the county court in which he serves. He shall receive \$50 per diem for each day on which he actually serves and his actual and neces-sary expenses for such time as the administrator determines and until his successor is elected or appointed and qualifies, whichever is sooner, if the total per diem expenses and retirement benefits paid to said designee do not exceed the salary of a sitting county judge, and such compensation is ap-portioned between the state and the county on the same basis as the present apportionment of the salaries of other county judges. SECTION 3. This bill is declared to be an emergency appropriation bill, recommended by the joint committee on finance, in accordance with the re-quirements of section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
