CHAPTER 208, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 66.919 (15) (e) of the statutes, relating to municipalities paying premiums required to be paid by employer for group life insurance.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.919 (15) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.919 (15) (e) Each municipality shall pay the employer cost for its personnel pursuant to sub. (8) (d), and may pay any part or all of the premium required to be paid by an employe pursuant to sub. (8) (a). If a municipality elects to pay the entire premium, it shall notify the board in writing of the month in which such election shall be in effect. Notwith-standing sub. (5) (b), a waiver of insurance filed by any employe of such municipality shall be revoked and such employe shall be insured commencing on the first day of the month in which such municipal election becomes effective or on the first day of the month next following receipt of notice by the board, whichever is later. The board shall determine the method of administration including the procedure for the collection of premiums and municipality costs. The board shall provide for pooling the employer costs which shall be determined separately for all employes covered under this subsection.
