CHAPTER 210, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 201.03 (6) of the statutes, relating to the amendment of the articles of incorporation of a mutual insurance company.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

201.03 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

201.03 (6) The charter of any mutual insurance company incorporated under special act and, unless otherwise provided therein, the articles of incorporation of any mutual insurance company may be amended by a vote of three-fourths of the members voting at a meeting after the proposed amendment has been filed with its secretary and the commissioner and a copy thereof with notice of time and place of meeting has been mailed to each member. In addition to lieu of the foregoing notification to each member, and notwithstanding any specific provision in the charter or articles of incorporation, the company shall publish a copy of such notice as a class 2 notice, under ch. 985, together with such additional notice as the commissioner requires.
