CHAPTER 214, LAWS OF 1967

- AN ACT to renumber 15.98; and to amend 39.021 (3) and (5), as renumbered, of the statutes, relating to the assignment of the educational approval council to the department of public instruction.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
- SECTION 1. 15.98 of the statutes is renumbered 39.021 and 39.021 (3) and (5), as renumbered, are amended to read:

39.021 (3) There is created the educational approval council to consist of such representatives of state agencies and such other persons with a demonstrated interest in educational programs as the governor selects. Members of the council shall serve at the convenience of the governor. The council shall prescribe rules and establish standards necessary to carry out its purpose. The council shall, for administrative purposes, be attached to the department of public instruction.

(5) The council shall employ a person to perform the duties of an executive secretary and such other persons under the classified service as may be necessary to carry out its purpose. The administrative functions of the council shall be in charge of the person performing the duties of the

executive secretary. The council shall keep its office at the state capitol in the department of public instruction.

SECTION 2. The assignment of the educational approval council to the department of public instruction by this act, shall supersede any assignment of the educational approval council made by Senate Bill 55. Approved November 21, 1967.
