CHAPTER 24, LAWS OF 1967

- AN ACT to amend 62.09 (6) (b) of the statutes, relating to mid-term salary increases for nonpolicy-making elected city officers.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
 - 62.09 (6) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 62.09 (6) (b) Whenever such salaries are to be changed or established the council shall, not later than the first regular meeting in February, fix the amount of salary of each officer entitled to a salary who may be elected

or appointed for a definite term during the ensuing year. The salary of an officer so elected shall not be increased or diminished during his term of office. In cities newly incorporated the compensation of the first officers may be fixed during their terms.
