- AN ACT to amend 59.87 (2) and 141.01 (2) (a) of the statutes, relating to members of the county health commission and the agriculture committee.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
 - SECTION 1. 59.87 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 59.87 (2) If the county board of supervisors determines to establish a co-operative extension service, it shall create a committee on agriculture

consisting of the chairman of the board and 3 or more other members of the board selected by the board. The vocation of a majority of the members of the committee shall be agriculture in counties where membership with such qualifications is available. The county board may select as an additional a member of the committee any public school administrator resident in the county. The members of the committee, including such additional member if one has been selected, shall receive such compensation and expenses as the board determines under the authority of s. 59.15 (2) (c) and (3). The committee shall meet at such intervals as is deemed necessary to properly carry out its functions and responsibilities.

SECTION 2. 141.01 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

141.01 (2) (a) Not less than 5 One or more members of the county board and the district health officer, ex officio; or
