CHAPTER 251, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT authorizing and directing the state conservation commission to sell at public or private sale certain lands in the northern highland state forest.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The state conservation commission is authorized and directed to sell at public or private sale for fair appraised value and thereupon to convey to the purchaser thereof by quitclaim deed the following described lands situated in the county of Vilas, state of Wisconsin:

A part of Government Lot 4 as herein described:

Commencing at the one-quarter section corner between Sections 23 and 24, T41N, R6E, thence east along the quarter line of said Section 24 a distance of 383 feet to the point of beginning, thence east along the quarter line a distance of 476 feet, more or less, to the shore of Trout Lake, thence south 100 feet, thence easterly

and parallel to said quarter line 476 feet, more or less, to a point which is south from the point of beginning, thence north 100 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.1 acres, more or less.
