CHAPTER 255, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to create 945.01 (2) (b) 2.e of the statutes, permitting lotteries at trade fairs and shows.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

945.01 (2) (b) 2.e of the statutes is created to read:

945.01 (2) (b) 2. e. To fill out a coupon or entry blank obtained and deposited on the premises of a bona fide trade fair or trade show defined as an exhibition by 5 or more competitors of goods, wares or merchandise at a location other than a retail establishment or shopping center or other place where goods and services are customarily sold; but if an admission fee is charged to such exhibition all facilities for obtaining and depositing coupons or entry blanks shall be outside the area for which an admission fee is required.
