CHAPTER 260, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 144.025 (5) (a) of the statutes, relating to regional advisory boards.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

144.025 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

144.025 (5) (a) There shall be a regional water resources advisory board for each region composed of the regional director, who shall serve as executive secretary; an employe of the state board of health serving in the region, appointed by and serving at the pleasure of the state health officer; an employe of the conservation department serving the region, appointed by and serving at the pleasure of the conservation director; and 5 citizen members appointed by and serving at the pleasure of the governor. The first appointees shall be named no later than February 1, 1967. The executive director of the Minnesota-Wisconsin boundary area commission shall serve as a member for regions contiguous to the Minnesota boundary. The officers of the regional boards shall be selected from the citizen members.
