CHAPTER 298, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 141.06 of the statutes, relating to county public health nurses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

141.06 of the statutes is amended to read:

- 141.06 COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH NURSES, SANITARIANS AND OTHER PUBLIC HEALTH PERSONNEL. (1) The county health committee may employ one or more county public health nurses, sanitarians, or other public health personnel, when so authorized by the county board, to conduct a generalized public health nursing program, environmental sanitation, or other public health programs pursuant to the direction and under the supervision of the county health committee in co-operation with the state board of health.
- (2) The work of the county nurse, county sanitarian and other public health personnel shall be directed by a county health committee composed either of the chairman of the county board, a woman appointed by the county board, the judge of the juvenile court and the district health officer or county physician for that county, or of the district health officer and not less than 5 members of the county board appointed by the chairman thereof of 5 or more members appointed by the chairman, at least 3 of which shall be members of the county board, and a representative of the state board of health appointed by the state health officer.
- (3) The county board shall fix the salary of the county nurse approve and make necessary appropriations an appropriation to carry out the previsions of this subsection (1); provided, that the county board may at any time discontinue the services of the county nurse at the expiration of her contract.
