## CHAPTER 3, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 20.530 (1) (a) 1. c of the statutes, authorizing legislators to attend meetings.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

20.530 (1) (a) 1.c of the statutes is amended to read:

20.530 (1) a) 1. c. Members of the legislature authorized by the governor, or senators so authorized by the committee on senate organization, or assemblymen so authorized by the committee on assembly organization for out-of-state meetings or the speaker for meetings within this state, and all members of the legislature required by law, by the governor, by legislative rule or by resolution or joint resolution to attend meetings other than sessions of the legislature or to represent the this state in their official capacity shall be paid no additional compensation for such services but shall be reimbursed their actual and necessary expenses. A legislator shall not be reimbursed under subd. 1. e. this provision for expenses incurred for any day, for which day he makes claim under subd. 1. f.
