The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

111.70 (3) (a) 3 of the statutes is created to read:

111.70 (3) (a) 5 of the statutes is created to read:
111.70 (3) (a) 3. Prohibiting a duly authorized representative of an organization certified pursuant to sub. (4) (d) or (j) from appearing before any governmental unit or body but nothing herein shall prevent the enactment of reasonable rules adopted by the employer necessary to maintain continuity of public service or the adoption of a negotiated agreement on the subject.
