CHAPTER 330, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to create 20.420 (5) of the statutes, relating to the construction of a bridge in Menominee county and providing an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. At the appropriate place in the schedule of section 20.005 of the statutes insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

20.420 Highway commission

1967-68 1968-69

Bridge construction in Men-

ominee county

(5) (a) C 78,000

SECTION 2. 20.420 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

20.420 (5) BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION IN MENOMINEE COUNTY. (a) Bridge construction. As a continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule from the highway fund for the purpose of constructing a bridge in Menominee county to cross the Wolf river at Keshena.
