CHAPTER 334, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 185.981 (2) of the statutes, relating to co-operative sickness care.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

185.981 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

185.981 (2). Such associations shall operate only on a co-operative nonprofit basis and for the purpose of establishing, maintaining and operating a voluntary nonprofit medical or dental care plan or plans or for constructing, operating and maintaining nonprofit hospitals or other facilities whereby sickness of care, including hospital care or dental care, is provided at the expense of such association to such persons or groups of persons as shall become subscribers to such plan, under contracts which will entitle each such subscriber to definite medical, surgical, dental, or hospital care, appliances and supplies, by physicians and surgeons licensed and registered under s. 147.175, or by and dentists licensed under s. 152.05 in their offices, in hospitals, in other facilities and in the home.
