CHAPTER 354, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 150.05 (2) [and (4); and to create 150.05 (5)] of the statutes, relating to the licensing of technicians doing animal pregnancy examinations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 150.05 (2) [and (4)] of the statutes are [is] amended to read:

150.05 (2) No license shall be required for artificial insemination, or for continuing the practice of pregnancy examinations of animals when such practice was engaged in prior to the effective date of this amendment and for castrating, except for horses and dogs, or dehorning animals; for students at a veterinary college approved by the board, while working under the supervision of a licensed veterinarian; for employes of the state or federal government while engaged in their official duties; or for employes of an educational or research institution while engaged in teaching or research.
