CHAPTER 39, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 40.77 (l) (b); and to create 40.77 (l) (d) of the statutes, relating to compulsory school attendance requirements.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 40.77 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

40.77 (1) (b) This subsection does not apply to any child who is not in proper physical or mental condition to attend school (the certificate of a reputable physician in general practice shall be sufficient proof that a child is unable to attend school) nor, to any child exempted for good cause by the school district board or board of education of the school district in which the child resides, nor or to any child who has completed the full 4-year high school course. Any child who has completed the first 8 grades of school work or the equivalent thereof may at his option attend a vocational and adult education school full time in lieu of attendance at any other school.

SECTION 2. 40.77 (1) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

40.77 (1) (d) A school board may permit a pupil who is in good standing academically to attend school part-time during his last school term preceding graduation from high school.
