CHAPTER 4, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 14.95 (3) of the statutes, relating to the meetings of the state commission on aging.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

14.95 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

14.95 (3) The commission shall meet annually during the first week in January, April, July and October at least quarterly and may meet at such other times as the board determines or the board directs. The governor shall call the first meeting at the time specified herein. The Commission shall annually elect from its membership a chairman and vice chairman. The executive director shall act as secretary, but shall have no vote. A majority of the commission constitutes a quorum. Approved March 21, 1967.
