CHAPTER 67, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 29.57 (4) of the statutes, relating to wildlife refuges. The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

29.57 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.57 (4) No owner of lands embraced within any such wildlife refuge, and no other person whatever, shall hunt or trap within the boundaries of any wildlife refuge, state park except deer on Rock Island state park, or state fish hatchery lands; nor have in his possession or under his control therein any gun or rifle, unless the same is unloaded and knocked down or enclosed within its carrying case; but *deer may be hunted in those state parks or portions thereof designated by the conservation commission*. Nothing herein in this section shall prohibit, prevent or interfere with the state conservation commission, or its deputies, agents or employes, in the destruction of injurious animals.
