CHAPTER 79, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to create 23.11 (4) of the statutes, relating to police supervision on lands under the supervision of the conservation commission.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

23.11 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

23.11 (4) The commission shall have police supervision over all state-owned lands and property under its supervision, management and control, and its duly appointed agents or representatives may arrest, with or without warrant, any person within such area, committing an offense against the laws of this state or in violation of any rule of the commission in force in such area, and deliver such person to the proper court of the county wherein such offense has been committeed and make and execute a complaint charging such person with the offense committed. The district attorney of the county wherein such offense has been committed shall appear and prosecute all actions arising under this subsection.
