## CHAPTER 8, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 20.530 (1) (a) 7 of the statutes, relating to contingent expenses of the legislature.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

20.530 (1) (a) 7 of the statutes is amended to read:
20.530 (1) (a) 7. All moneys appropriated for the contingent expenses of the senate and the assembly shall be credited to the contingent funds of

the senate and assembly, respectively, and shall be paid from such funds only as provided by the rules of the senate or assembly and as directed by a resolution of each house or by a joint resolution specifying the amount to be paid and the purpose of the expenditure. Each payment shall be authorized by at least 2 of the 3 members of the organization committee of the respective house, and payments from the contingent funds of either house shall be made upon certification by the chief clerk of that house eiting, in each instance, the rule or resolution authorizing the payment. Approved March 22, 1967.
