AN ACT to amend 985.07 (3) (b) of the statutes, relating to classes and frequency of legal notices.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

985.07 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

985.07 (3) (b) Any legal notice not otherwise designated shall be a class 3 notice unless the time permitted by law necessitates a class 2 or class 1 notice, except that any notice required by law on January 2, 1966, which is not otherwise designated, shall be a class 1 notice.
